

ESPON 2020 PROGRAMME

"Inspire policy making with territorial evidence"

- Supports local, regional and national development in Europe gathering different policy makers that share the same challenges and that are looking for new territorial evidences.
- Supports political decision making process providing the scientific evidences needed, creating networks of key stakeholders and decision makers, promoting the role of the territory as a place where connection and knowledge exchange happen.
- Tool: **Targeted Analysis** = financing an activity of high-level research in Europe.





ESPON METRO THE OBJECTIVE

Main objective: solve the current mismatch between the concentration of GDP, the amount of the population and the volume of the resources managed.

Political objective: identification of empirical and scientific evidences in support of a greater involvement of metropolitan cities in the programming phase of the cohesion policy at national and regional level.

Why? 68% of the European GDP has been generated in metropolitan regions in 2014 and it is expected that 80% of the population will live in urban areas by 2050.



RESULTS EXPECTED

Develop a *Targeted Analysis* that allows the stakeholders group to define the current status and trend in order to provide:

- a map of the state of art of Metropolitan Areas and Cities and their interrelations with cohesion policy;
- an analysis of strategic planning policy documents and how they include or could include cohesion policy in the future;
- an analysis of funding sources and types of instruments used;
- pan-european results of actions implemented;
- recommendations for cities and institutions on:
 - 1. how to better use cohesion policy to foster strategic planning
 - 2. how to implement integrated territorial development and area-based approaches thanks to the cohesion policy
